INTERPRETATION OF STATUTES - Constitution of Statutory provisions - 0.6, r. 2 Court of Appeal Rules 1981 - where ordinary plain words will be absurd - duty of court. Obomhense v. Erhahon. P.78 SC

ISLAMIC LAW - Real property - where defendant has been in undisturbed possession for more than 10 years whether Plaintiff can succeed in claim of ownership of the Land. Hada v. Malumfashi P.102 SC

JURISDICTION - Provisions in a statute suggesting deprivation of court's jurisdiction - how construed. Udoh v. Orth Hosp. Mgt. Bd. P.67 SC

JURISDICTION - Whether determined only by the nature of the claim before the court - whether there are other considerations affecting the determination of the court's Jurisdiction. Justice Kalu Anya v. Dr F.

JURISDICTION - Islamic law - land dispute - claim by Plaintiff based on allegation that defendant held the land on trust - whether established. Hada v. Malumfashi P.102 SC

MAXIMS - Expressio unius est exclusius alterius - its application in the interpretation of statutes. Udo v. Orth. Hosp. Mgt, Bd. P.67 SC

MURDER - Absence of evidence of cause of death - accused withholding true circumstance of deceased's death - whether court can pressure that accused killed the deceased. Ariche v. State P.44 SC

MURDER - Unequivocal evidence pointing to accused as the only one with deceased up to her death - whether evidence is sufficient to ground conviction. Ariche v. State P.4S SC

MURDER - Where there is no direct evidence - circumstances pointing to the accused as responsible - whether court can rightly convict. Ariche v. State P.44 SC

PRACTICE OF PROCEDURE - Periods within which briefs of argument must be filed by parties - whether time begins to run from the time of actual collection of record of proceedings - or time of receipt of registrar's invitation. Obomhense v. Erhahon. P.78 SC

PRACTICE & PROCEDURE - Failure of Appellant to collect records of proceedings in time - Respondent applying to court to dismiss the appeal - Appellant in turn applying to file additional grounds of appeal - whether Appellant's conduct amounts to Laxity - sufficient to lead to dismissal of the appeal.
