APPEALS - No ground attacking lower court's finding in respect of an issue - whether appellant can question that finding (p.99) SC

APPEALS - Error in law by Court of Appeal - no miscarriage of justice occasioned thereby - whether judgment will be reversed (p.128) SC

APPEALS - Land dispute - trial court's finding - not supplied by evidence - whether Court of Appeal's reversal of the finding was justified (p.128) SC

APPEALS - Damages for trespass - excessive award by trial court - attitude of appeal court thereto (p.151) SC

APPEALS - Court of Appeal's error - in wrongfully deeming a prayer in a motion paper as abandoned and dead - where that prayer could not have been granted - whether appellant suffered any injustice thereby (p.152) SC

G PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE - Moving of motion supported by affidavit - Counsel's silence in respect of a prayer - whether that prayer should be deemed as abandoned and dead (p. 152) SC

TORTS - Vicarious liability - whether a Company owner of vehicle is vicariously liable - for the negligent driving of its employee (p. 70) SC
