

FAIR HEARING - Denial - Of fair hearing - Where the courts carefully considered all the questions raised by the appellant - He was not denied fair hearing. Amokeodo v. Inspector General of Police p. 1105

JUDGMENTS - Injunction - Consequential orders - Order of injunction - Granted suo motu by the court in favour of the respondents - Is proper - Since title to the land in dispute has been declared in their favour. Bunyan v. Akingboye p. 1021

MASTER & SERVANT - Retirement notice - Dismissal - Of the appellant - Within the period of his retirement notice - Is the exercise of the right of the respondents over one of its serving officers. Amokeodo v. Inspector General of Police p. 1105

MASTER AND SERVANT - Termination - Contract of service - Where it is written - The Court will not look outside the terms - In deciding the rights and obligations of the parties. Katto v. Central Bank of Nigeria p. 1047

MURDER - Witnesses - Proof - Of the identity of the deceased - Desirability of calling the person who identified the corpse as a witness - Is only where the identity of the body examined by the doctor - Is in doubt. Idemudia v. The State p. 1075

EVIDENCE - Evaluation of evidence - Expert evidence - Where the evidence given by the expert witnesses did not pass the legal requirement - Rejection of their evidence by the trial judge was right. Ogiale v. Shell Petroleum p. 1133 CA
