## **INDEX OF SUBJECT MATTER IN (2001) 1 KLR   vii**

**ACTIONS** - Customary court - Representative action - Meaning of a representative - It must be apparent on the record - That the suit is defended on behalf of one's family. Okukuje v. Akwido p. 1

**APPEALS** - Concurrent findings of fact - Will not be interfered with by Supreme Court - In the absence of sufficient reasons. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**APPEALS** - Specific findings - That was not challenged - Cannot be appealed against. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**CUSTOMARY LAW** - Judicial notice - Notoriety of custom - Doctrine of priority under Bini customary law fulfills the condition. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**ESTOPPEL** - Issue estoppel - Parties must be the same in both cases - For the question of issue estoppel to arise. Okukuje v. Akwido p. 1

**ESTOPPEL** - Representative and personal capacity - Sameness of judgment - Will not arise to warrant estoppel - Where present action is prosecuted in a different capacity. Okukuje v. Akwido p. 1

**ESTOPPEL** - Res judicata - For the doctrine to apply - Parties, issues and subject matter - Must be the same. Okukuje v. Akwido p. 1

**ESTOPPEL** - Res judicata or estoppel of record - Arises where an issue of fact has been judicially determined in a final manner - Between the parties or their privies. Okukuje v. Akwido p. 1

**ESTOPPEL** - Subject matter - Res judicata - Land dispute - Difference in subject matter - Will make the plea of estoppel inapplicable. Okukuje v. Akwido p. 1

**LAND LAW** - Bini customary law - Alienation - Whether by formal conveyance or not - Goes to no issue - As far as there is transfer of estate

or interest - And purchaser is in peaceful possession. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Bini customary law - Oba's approval - Marks complete transfer of legal estate. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Bini customary law - Priority - Applies only to claims in respect of same land. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Bini customary law - Title - Equal equities - The 1st in time prevails. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Competing claims - Priority doctrine - Applies to both legal and equitable titles. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Family land - Proper party to sue or be joined should have been the family - Irrespective of allotment of the land. Okukuje v. Akwido p. 1

**LAND LAW** - Title - Concrete and indefeasible title - Must be established by plaintiff to sustain his claim. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Title - Nemo dat quod non habet - One cannot convey title from a void or nonexistent title. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Title - Onus of proof - Plaintiff must prove both the purchase of the land and priority of his purchase. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Title - Proof - Must be on the strength of plaintiff's case - Not on weakness of the defence. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**LAND LAW** - Title - Proof of legal estate - Is sufficient to give title - Even in the absence of evidence of conveyance. Ojo v. Azama p. 81

**MASTER & SERVANT** - Conditions of employment - Termination of

appointment - Must comply with terms or conditions of employment. Obo v. Comm. For Educ. Bendel State p. 105

**MASTER & SERVANT** - Fair hearing - Termination of appointment - Without query - No breach of fair hearing - Where plaintiff had repudiated the contract of employment by abandonment. Obo v. Comm. For Educ. Bendel State p. 105

**MASTER & SERVANT** - Fraudulent enrichment - Where servant knowingly received and spent salary to which he was not entitled - It is fraudulent and is recoverable. Obo v. Comm. For Educ. Bendel State p. 105

**MASTER & SERVANT** - Termination of appointment - Where wrongful - Will attract only stipulated damages - Defendants cannot be compelled to accept services. Obo v. Comm. For Educ. Bendel State p. 105

**WORDS & PHRASES** - Capacity of action - "Where an action is brought against the defendant personally and prosecuted to judgment" - Meaning of this phrase - Requirement in trials before native courts. Okukuje v. Akwido p. 1

**JUDGMENTS** - Undefended list - Audi alteram partem principle - Should make Courts give a hearing - To a litigant who wants to be heard. CCB v. Samed Inv. Co. Ltd p. 117 CA

**JUDGMENTS** - Undefended suit O. 24 r. 9 (4) - Where bonafide issue for trial is not raised - The Rules did not say that judgment shall be entered for plaintiff - Plaintiff shall still give evidence. CCB v. Samed Inv. Co. Ltd p. 117 CA

**PRACTICE & PROCEDURE** - Undefended suit - Notice of intention to defend - Raised a bonafide issue - And the case should be entered in the general list. CCB v. Samed Inv. Co. Ltd p. 117 CA
