

AFFIDAVITS - Contents - By Evidence Act ss. 86 & 87 - Affidavit shall contain only facts - Derived from personal knowledge of deponent - And not objection or legal argument (H4) Okponipere v. State p. 1119

COURTS - Supervisory role - Certiorari - The writ is available under the 1999 Constitution and High Court Rules - To empower High Courts to checkmate - The arbitrariness of inferior courts or Tribunals (H1) State v. Lawal p. 1181

DAMAGES - Contract - Torts - Since chattel does not include abstract money - The award of N2 million based on detinue is wrong - As measure of damages in tort is not the same as in contract (H2) Aminu Ishola Invest. Ltd v. Afribank Plc p. 1025

JURISDICTION - National Industrial Court - Trade dispute - For jurisdiction of the court to arise - It must be established that the subject matter comes within the Trade Dispute Act s. 47(1) (H7) Osoh v. Unity Bank Plc. 1133

MASTER & SERVANT - Termination - Damages in action for termination of employment - Can only follow events - Where the termination is wrongful (H5) Osoh v. Unity Bank Plc. 1133
